The RV *Kaharoa* (nine adopted floats) has completed float deployments with the *Maritime HS ROV Club* being the last one deployed and the *Lindblad Explorer* (five adopted floats) will be departing soon (there will be a blog from the *Lindblad*). The RV *David Packard* (four floats are adopted) is scheduled to leave Spain in September (another delay) heading for the Panama Canal.
